

Capital Campaign Update as of September 5, 2022

235 parishioners and friends contributed to our Capital Campaign and enabled us to surpass our goal for a total of \$2,088,506.00. Thank you to all our faithful who have made a commitment in support of our parish.

A temporary signboard has been placed in the back of the church to recognize gifts made in memory, in honor or on behalf as requested by donors. After church interior plaster repair and painting is completed, we will address a permanent design.

The redemption phase of our campaign will begin in mid-September. Donors will receive reminders via email or US post.

Projects in process:

- Painting of the church exterior should begin shortly.
- Installation of an automatic door opener for the ramped church entrance nearest the school is being scheduled. Waiting on back ordered parts.
- Conversion of the convent heating system from oil to gas is almost complete.
- School boilers have been installed and necessary plumbing, electrical and software work is in progress.

Projects completed:

- Technology upgrades have been made to improve school Wi-Fi access and back up.
- A new fire alarm panel for the school has been installed.
- Safety features have been added to the 2 sets of school gymnasium doors. They now have an automatic closure mechanism connected to the fire alarm. If the fire alarm is engaged, the fireproof doors will close to help contain the fire.
- Church, rectory, and chapel lots have been paved and striped.
- The bridges over the driveways on both church lot entrances were repaired.
- The climate control software at the school has been updated.
- The school construction loan was paid in full.
- Windows on the first floor of the convent were replaced.
