### As of 11/6/23:

\$1,545,000 has been gifted through the campaign \$910,000 utilized for the completed projects listed below.

### Projects in process:

- Exterior school boiler room doors to be replaced.

### Projects completed:

- **CHURCH** - The bridges over the driveways on both lot entrances were repaired. Church, rectory, and chapel lots were paved and striped. Dead/dying trees removed, others trimmed. The exterior carpentry was repaired and painted; the carport roof was repaired. Interior plaster repair and painting of water-damaged areas on walls and ceiling. Installed automatic door opener for the ramped church choir entrance. Phase 1 & 2 repairs to our church organ. Replaced and/or repaired exterior signs.
- **RECTORY** - Replaced leaking water heater, repair and restoration of foundation and structural supports.
- **SCHOOL** - Construction loan paid in full. Boilers were replaced and necessary plumbing, electrical, and software work was completed. Replace compromised school HVAC units with mini-AC/heating units in faculty and Msgr. Torney rooms. Drainage issues have been addressed to alleviate boiler room flooding. Climate control software has been updated. A new fire alarm panel was installed. An automatic closure mechanism connected to the fire alarm was added to the gymnasium doors. Technology upgrades were made to improve school Wi-Fi access and backup. Two outdated Automatic External Defibrillators were replaced. Dead, dying trees removed, others trimmed.
- **CONVENT** – Replaced windows on the first floor, heating system converted from oil to gas, and installed generator. Convent chimneys have been repaired.
